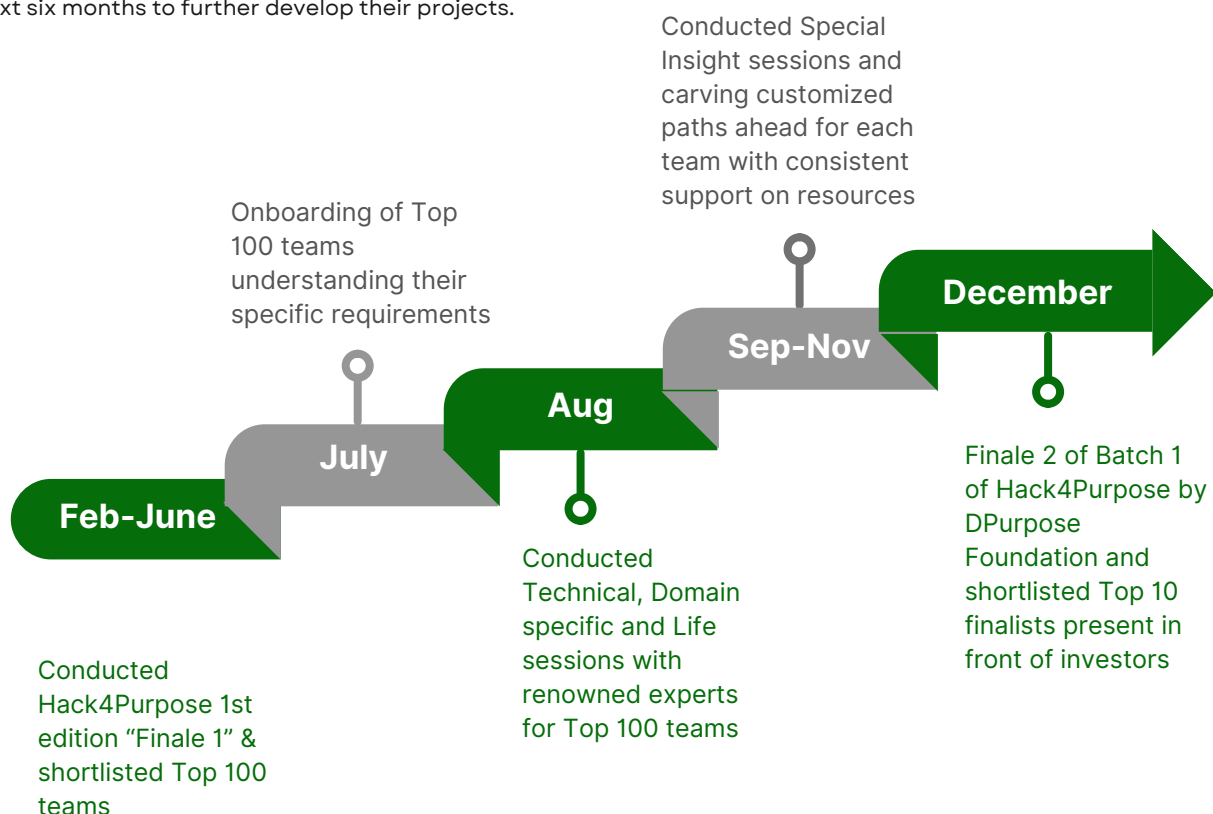

DPurpose Foundation through our hackathon, Hack4Purpose identifies innovations that greatly enable sustainability and provides end-to-end support to convert ideas to a minimum viable product (MVP). Through access to domain experts, visionaries, passionate entrepreneurs, pre-seed/seed investors, donors, one-to-one mentorship, pre-incubation trainers and particularly mental health and motivation to carve their entrepreneurial path.



Our journey so far....

Phase 1 of Hack4Purpose 1st Edition took place on June 26th and 27th at Anna University, Chennai, Tamil Nadu. The event brought together the shortlisted Top 100 teams from across India, who presented their innovative ideas to a panel of 33 distinguished judges, each an expert in their respective fields. The Top 5 winners were announced, receiving cash prizes, while all 100 teams were awarded participation certificates and the college with highest applications was bestowed National Sustainability award. Feedback was collected from every team to help us enhance future editions of Hack4Purpose. All Top 100 teams were onboarded to receive tailored support for the next six months to further develop their projects.



Phase 2 of Hack4Purpose 1st Edition focused on supporting and understanding the unique needs of each team to transform their ideas into impactful outcomes. A variety of sessions, including technical sessions, domain-specific discussions, and life skills training, were organized to provide holistic guidance. Personalized Insight Sessions were also conducted to assess each team's plans and offer tailored suggestions. Over six months, teams submitted training and project refinement reports, showcasing their progress and consistency. Based on these evaluations, the Top 10 teams were selected to advance to Finale 2, where they received opportunity to pitch their refined ideas to a panel of distinguished investors. Special Purpose Awards were presented to 10+ teams including Best of Pitch award as well.

THE United Nations' community-driven UNLEASH initiative redefines "hacks" as "local innovation sprints for young people to address their region's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)." With this in mind, city-based DPurpose Foundation partnered with UNLEASH to host a nationwide hackathon for student entrepreneurs. The event had 8,500 youngsters participating from 16 states. Of them, 100 teams were selected by a panel of 33 judges based on their initial proposals submitted in May. These proposals identified a problem or market gap and proposed a solution.

The 400 selected students gathered at Anna University's Tag Auditorium. The judges, all leaders in their fields, shared their entrepreneurial insights.

Francis Somerwell, founder, innovator, and strategic scientist, emphasised that innovation isn't possible without purpose. "We need to live by this Gandhian saying: When we find purpose, the means will follow," he advised.

Hacking for a purpose

This resonated with many students who had struggled to bring their ideas to life due to a lack of guidance, resources, or funding. Desika Prabakar, CEO, DPurpose, explained, "There is a huge gap between academia and industry. I've worked with universities and corporates. I wanted to do something to bridge this gap. In the end, I want to build an ecosystem for making connections — for students and mentors. Even if you don't win, you walk away with exposure and a prime opportunity to network."

The teams had two or four participants presenting their solutions covering various industries and concerns, including health, agriculture, disability, construction, waste management, automobiles, and more.

The first prize was a tie between two teams, each receiving ₹1 lakh. Chittaranjan Behera, Rasmiranjan Sahoo, Sagarika Swain, and Sajjan Kumar from Driems University, Odisha, developed a recycling system to generate electricity from waste. Meanwhile, Hemasri M, Pranav Aditya PS, Harini S, and Priyanka B from Bannari Amman Institute of Technology, Erode, created technology for precision agriculture to minimise yield loss.

The all-female NutriMasters team (Fashtana Khan and Khadija Mogal) from Mumbai won the second prize for creating healthy crackers for diabetics. The third prize went to G Sravan Kumar, SK Munna Mehith, B Sai Prasad, and T Anusha from Andhra Pradesh for developing CLOUDEE. A special mention was given to Deepak Singh, Harsh Kumar, Shubnam Joshi, and Jyoti Mathpal from Uttarakhand. The selected teams will receive financial support from the UNLEASH programme. DPurpose has also launched the URU (You are you) platform to provide consistent support to young innovators.
